Treasurer Report Forms (TRFs) – All club treasurers, be sure to turn in your July TRFs if you have not done so. These forms are also due on the first of every month.

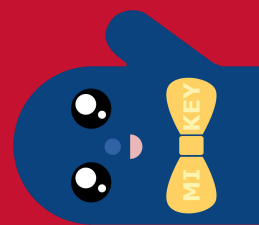
# WHAT HAVE I BEEN DOING?

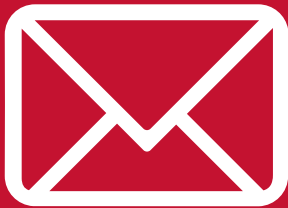
