REPORT FORMS

Election Report Forms (ERFs) – All club secretaries, please work on getting your ERFs in! You should fill these out as soon as your elections are over so that we can get the information ASAP. The final due date for these forms is October 1.

Monthly Report Forms (MRFs) – The May MRFs also need to be filled out by all club secretaries, and these forms are due on the first of every month.

Treasurer Report Forms (TRFs) – All club treasurers, be sure to turn in your May TRFs if you have not done so. These forms are also due on the first of every month.

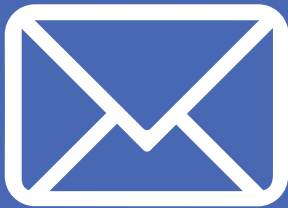
