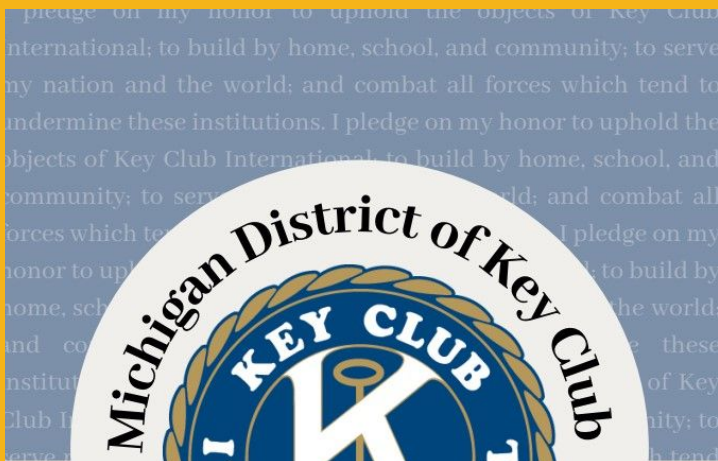

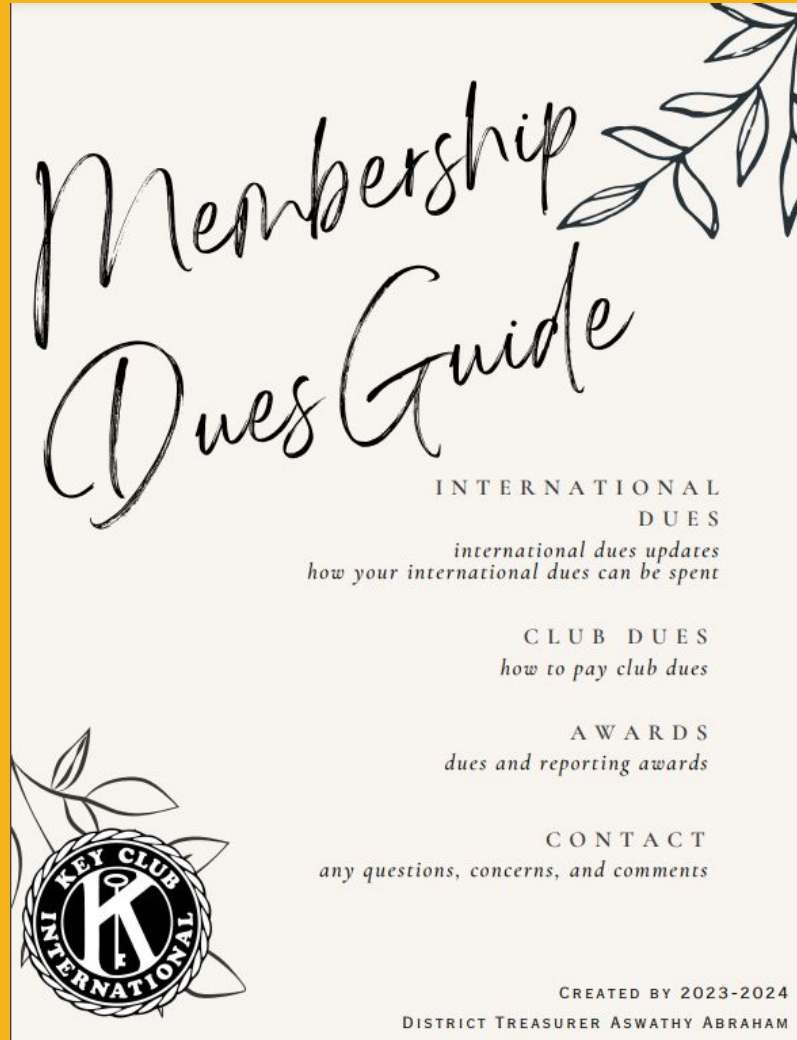

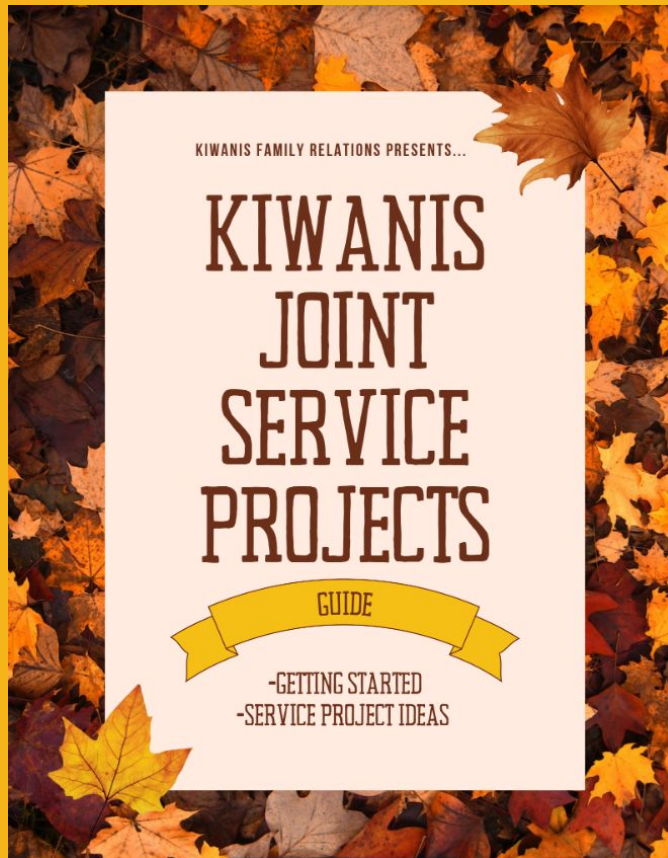

Youth Opportunities Fund

The Youth Opportunities Fund (YOF) grant is available for Key Clubs in good standing to apply for support with a service project. A Key Club in good standing means that the club's yearly dues must be paid before you can qualify to receive a grant from the Kiwanis Children's Fund.

The service project that you use the YOF funds for must meet certain requirements in order to qualify, which you can learn more about [here](#).

Applications for the first funding cycle will be due on October 15th of this year, and Key Club International will decide which clubs receive grants a month later.

The final report will be due by December 31st, 2024.
