 - Clubs that have already submitted one do not need to again

Monthly Report Forms (MRF):

- Due November 1
 - Secretaries fill this out
- MRFs allow us to see how your club is doing, what you expect to do in the future, and what you need help with.

Treasurer Report Form (TRF):

- Due at the start of each month!
 - Treasurers fill this out
- These forms are to help Aswathy Abraham see where each club is at for their finances, club dues, etc. This is mandatory for all clubs!


